

OVERVIEW:

Laurencekirk, Aberdeenshire

Clark & Sutherland has now completed three projects with G&G Whyte of the Bent Farm, Laurencekirk. In 2012 we installed a conveying system to fill "Store 1". In 2014, having built a second store (Store 2) along with a Dutch barn to house the mobile drier and bulk hopper, we installed a conveyor to piggyback into the existing machinery. This was purposely installed high at the drive with the view to install store filling equipment to Store 2 in the future.

THE PROJECT:

G&G Whyte approached Clark & Sutherland again to design, manufacture and install a grain transfer system into Store 2. The elevator and store filling set up was to be a copy of the system we installed into Store 1 in 2012, with one or two alterations to the overhead conveyor.

We installed a Perry's of Oakley horizontal chain and flight store conveyor and a 60 beltand bucket elevator. We manufactured and installed ducting to connect the system as well as an access ladder and platform, in line with the current legislation and regulations.
